GENERATION AFRICA SHIFTING THE NARRATIVE: MIGRATION AND FILM PRODUCTION IN AFRICA

African Encounters! With a new name and concept, DOK.network Africa presents its Africa focus for the ninth time this year. "Africa Day" will become "African Encounters", with even more focus on exchange with filmmakers from the African continent!

This year, we will present the documentary film series "Generation Africa" by the South African non-profit media company STEPS. Young filmmakers from the African continent tell stories about migration from their point of view and thus want to shift perspectives about migration.

We will show four of these films: AFRICAN MOOT by Shameela Seedat takes us to a fictional court room: the best law students across Africa gather to negotiate the rights of refugees on the continent. HOME AGAIN by Babucarr Manka is about returnees who are to build up an existence in the Gambia and how they experience the reintergration policies.

Claudine Ndimbira from Rwanda demands all our attention and empathy for traumatised refugees with her short film LEND ME YOUR VOICE. And in NO SIMPLE WAY HOME we accompany Akuol de Mabior after years of exile in her search for home and identity in her country South Sudan. Four different stories about migration. Four stories about the young generation in Africa and their will of building a life with prospects on the ground.

In a panel discussion in collaboration with STEPS, DW Akademie, the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) and ARTE we will enter into a direct exchange with the filmmakers. On the one hand, it is about their view of migration: What does the change of perspective mean, especially for the young generation of the African continent? Can documentary film be political and contribute to change in reality? On the other hand, we will talk with the producers and broadcasters about new models of film production between Africa and Europe. *Barbara Off*
